This is planned for Friday 24th June and we are looking forward to working together to create some fabulous art work.

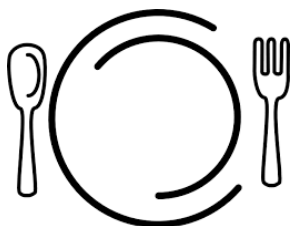
