<b>Whole School Vocabulary</b>	Pulse – the regular heartbeat of the music; the steady beat. Rhythm – long and short sounds or patterns that happen over the pulse, the steady beat. Pitch – high and low sounds. Tempo – the speed of the music – fast, slow or in-between. Dynamics – how loud or quiet music is. Timbre – all instruments, including voices have a certain sound quality, e.g. the trumpet has a very different sound quality to the violin. Texture – layers of sound working together make music very interesting to listen to. Structure – every piece of music has a structure, e.g. introduction, verse, chorus, ending.
